

HUNTER SSA SECONDARY SWIMMING TRIALS 2025

Information for Schools and Zones - The Forum - University of Newcastle

Date: Wednesday 12th March 2025

Time: Warm up is permitted in the main pool 8-8.30am – Events start at 9am

Management: The Trials are under the control of Steven Edwards – Whitebridge HS – Hunter SSA Convener

Entry: Entry for all competitors and spectators is through the signposted Gate Area at the front of the Venue. Attendees are NOT TO ENTER through the Forum entrance. Pass outs will be issued for any spectators or competitors that need to come and go through the day. Cost (Must be paid on the day) will be \$5.00 for competitors and \$5 for spectators. Cash and card will be accepted at the gate.

<u>Canteen:</u> Canteen facilities will be open at the venue. A BBQ will be set up on the walkway leading to the Pool and other items will be available from the Café in the foyer of the Forum. No food or drink should be consumed in the pool area.

Please see the attached map that indicates free parking areas located close to the Forum. Much of the University is paid parking and fines are issued by the University for any breaches. The indicated parking areas are free. Alternatively, there are plenty of trains that pass through the University station, Warrabrook (5 min walk to the pool) as well as plenty of buses from all over Newcastle that transit through the University.

Entries: Entries for this event can only be made through participation at Zone Carnivals. Zones are responsible for forwarding the top three advancers in each event to the Hunter Office in the correct Meet Manager format by Friday 1st March. NO ENTRIES will be accepted in any other format. The names of all students who have qualified for the Hunter Trial will be forwarded to schools on Tuesday 5th March. Please note that any students entering the distance events not swum at the Hunter Trial must complete the attached application form and submit it to the Hunter Office by Friday 1st March. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. MULTI CLASS Athletes MUST be entered by Zones in exactly the same way as other entries (through Meet Manager). All Multi Class athletes must be properly classified to be eligible to compete at the Hunter Event.

Management: Zones are required to nominate one staff member to act as Zone Manager on this day

Swimwear: Please note that there are rules in regard to the suitability of Swimwear that can be used at this event. As a general rule board shorts for boys and any revealing swimwear, bikinis or swimwear with a zip (Water Polo) cannot be worn. Please make students aware of these rules 12 x 50m KO Relay: Will be swum as per the Trial schedule-participating teams nominated in 2024.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This is a Swimming NSW approved meet. Times will be uploaded to the National Swimming Database
- 2. The Hunter Secondary Schools Swimming Carnival will be conducted under the Rules of Swimming NSW and aligned to the Combined High Schools Sports Association
- 3. Facility entry fee per swimmer and per parent/spectator (\$5) needs to be paid at the entrance to the Pool
- 4. Programs will NOT BE SOLD at this meet
- 5. Assisted self-marshalling for events will be used at this Carnival
- 6. Backstroke ledges will be available at this swim meet.

OLLY TIMING

Olly Timing is being used at this event. Olly Timing is the first of a new generation of swimming timing systems. It uses computer vision based artificial intelligence to 'see' swimmers touch the wall at the end of their races, without touchpads or timekeepers. Swimming NSW has validated Olly Timing for official times except for State records.

Olly Timing uses video photography. Cameras are located above and/or beside the ends of the pool. Competitors will be videoed for the purposes of timing and may also be used for other officiating purposes. Videos are stored on Olly Timing equipment. Competitors' times, events and heat numbers will be stored with the videos, but not their names. The data is accessible by swimming club officers, event technical officials, and Olly Timing staff. The data will be deleted 6 months after the event. Olly Timing staff attending this event have valid NSW Working With Children accreditations. Olly Timing adheres to all requirements under the Privacy Act 1988. The use of Olly Timing reduces the number of people on the pool deck with direct access to competitors.

Relay instructions for shallow end change-overs

When relays are conducted in pools where the depth at both ends of the pool does not allow for safe diving of competitors, all relays should be conducted in the following manner:

- Swimmers 1 and 3 will start as normal from the blocks at the deep end of the pool and the change-over between swimmers 2 and 3 will be normal.
- Swimmer 2 will enter the water at the shallow end of the pool. **Swimmer 2 will have one** hand on the top ledge of the pool until swimmer 1 touches the wall. Once swimmer 1 touches the wall, swimmer 2 is free to leave.
- If swimmer 2's hand leaves the top ledge before swimmer 1 touches the wall, they will be disqualified.
- Once swimmer 2 has left, then swimmer 1 will exit the water directly from their lane.
- Swimmer 4 will then enter the water and wait for swimmer 3. Change-over from swimmer 3 to 4 will follow the same procedure as swimmer 1 to 2.
