WWHS ATHLETICS CARNIVAL 2024 INFORMATION

Dear families,

West Wallsend High School's Athletics Carnival will be held at the Hunter Sports Centre, Glendale on Wednesday 1 May 2024 (Week 1 Term 2). This is a mandatory whole school event, and all students are required to attend. There will be no supervision at school on the day.

As per the school's personal technology policy students **must have all personal technology off and away in pouches all day.** Urgent communication to students on the day may be to our Head Teacher Administration on the school's excursion phone: **0439 150 907**.

COST

\$10 per student to be paid via the School Bytes online permission note <u>before</u> the event.

TRANSPORT

Bus transport: Students must be in the COLA by 8:45am for roll call. All students who catch a bus or walk home from school will leave the sports centre at 2:30pm by bus. Students will be dismissed from school at the usual bell time of 3:20pm.

Private transport: Students must arrive at the venue by 9:15am for roll call. All students are expected to remain at the carnival until 2:30pm when a roll call will be conducted. Students who are being picked up from the sports centre MUST have their parent/carer collect them from the attendance desk after the 2:30pm roll call has been completed and will only be allowed to leave the sports centre once their name is marked off.

Students may not leave the athletics carnival with another person without written permission from a parent/carer - this includes seniors driving with student passengers. All senior students travelling by car MUST complete a student driver/passenger consent form and submit this form to the front office by Monday 29 April. Senior students are expected to remain at the carnival until the 2.30pm roll call.

CARNIVAL DETAILS

Once students have their names marked off by their Connect teacher, students will be seated in house groups and should come wearing their house colours! Students will gain points for their houses for participation in age events. In the event of unsafe weather there will be an announcement made on our school Facebook page.

Students who finish first, second and third will automatically qualify for the Zone Carnival for that event. Students will represent West Wallsend High School at the Westlakes Zone Athletics Carnival on **Monday 27 May.** These students will receive additional information closer to the date.

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Students should bring a hat, sunscreen, appropriate running shoes, food, and a water bottle to stay hydrated. Students should be dressed in appropriate sun-safe athletic clothing.

FOOD

Students are to provide their own food and drink on the day. A canteen will be open during the day to purchase food (card or cash only).

SPECTATORS

Parents and carers are welcome to attend on the day to support their young person from the designated spectator area, located in the seated undercover grandstand area.

CAR PARKING

Due to ongoing construction works at the Hunter Sports Centre there will be no parking in the direct precinct of the centre. Spectators should strongly consider public transport or carpooling.



Preferred parking is available in Stockland Glendale (highlighted in green) requiring a short walk to Hunter Sports Centre.
